Utah Corrections and Salt Lake City School District to host inaugural high school graduation

What:

The Utah Department of Corrections (UDC) and Salt Lake City School District will host the inaugural high school graduation ceremony at 9 a.m., Monday, June 5, 2023, at the Utah State Correctional Facility (USCF) in Salt Lake City. While 39 students are eligible to graduate this school year, 29 students are expected to participate in the ceremony.

Not only will this be the first graduation at USCF, but it will also be the first graduation ceremony through the Salt Lake City School District.
