



## RELEASE DAY FAQ

### When and where does a person get released?

Releases/Paroles are processed every Tuesday. Most releases are processed and completed in the Visiting building at the Utah State Correctional Facility (1480 N. 8000 W Salt Lake City, UT 84116). ### My loved one is paroling to a Community Correctional Center (CCC/Halfway House), what do I need to do?

Nothing is required from you. Our Department of Corrections staff will transport the client to the designated CCC on his/her release day.

### My loved one is housed in a County Jail. Will they be released from the Utah State Correctional Facility or from the County Jail?

Almost everyone will be released from the Utah State Correctional Facility. There are extremely rare instances when someone is released from a county jail. If this will apply to your loved one, you will be notified.

### I am unable to pick up my loved one on release day, is transportation provided?

A member of our release team or a Utah Department of Corrections volunteer will take clients who do not have rides on release day to a UTA Trax station near the Utah State Correctional Facility (additional details will be provided on a case-by-case basis). Those who do not have a ride will be released last.
